Cookies Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.

Session cookies	<p>PHPSESSID - Generic PHP session cookie, used to identify a user for core PHP features</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <code>_ga</code> - Used to distinguish users. • <code>_gat</code> - Used to throttle request rate. • If Google Analytics is deployed via Google Tag Manager, this cookie will be named <code>_dc_gtm_<property-id></code>. • <code>_gid</code> - Used to distinguish users. 	All the other cookies are session only, meaning once you close your browser, the cookies are wiped.
WordPress cookies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <code>wordpress_logged_in_*</code> - used for defining a logged in users session • <code>wordpress_sec_*</code> - same as above • <code>wordpress_*</code> - same as above • <code>wordpress_test_cookie</code> - Tests that the browser accepts cookies. • <code>wp-settings-*</code> - Used to persist a user's wp-admin configuration.
